## **Increase the PHP File Upload Limit**

By default, XAMPP imposes a 128M limit on files uploaded through PHP. To increase the allowed file size for uploads through PHP, follow these steps:

 Edit the *php.ini* file in the *xamppfiles/etc/* subdirectory of your XAMPP installation directory (usually, /Applications/XAMPP). Within this file, find the *post\_max\_size* and *upload\_max\_filesize* variables and change them to reflect the new file upload limit. For example, to restrict uploads to not more than 16M, change these variables as shown below:

; Maximum size of POST data that PHP will accept. ; http://php.net/post-max-size post\_max\_size=16M ... ; Maximum allowed size for uploaded files. ; http://php.net/upload-max-filesize upload\_max\_filesize=16M

- 2. Save your changes to the file.
- 3. Restart the Apache server.

The new file upload limit will now come into effect.
